Pair of Beryl-Set Enamelled Gold Bangles (Kada) with Floral Motifs

These large, gold bangles, or kada, are decorated with enamel and set with light blue beryl. This type of bangle is from northwestern India, where they are worn in pairs on each arm in between smaller bracelets and bangles.
